## **How to...Assess and Manage Violence Risk Remotely (14 February 2023)**

The pandemic has increased the already growing demand for remote assessment and management of violence risk, introducing both challenging issues and promising practices. The workshop will cover: 1) legal, professional, and practical concerns about providing remote services, and 2) best practices related to conducting violence risk assessment and management at a distance.

## **How to...Sequence Parallel Investigations (18 April 2023)**

Conduct, harassment, and criminal investigations are distinct but often overlapping processes and can create problems for one another when not properly sequenced or coordinated. This workshop will cover: 1) the distinct purpose and nature of these investigations, and 2) best practices related to coordinating these investigations.

## **How to...Share Information (13 June 2023)**

Sharing information when there are concerns about violence risk is one of the most important and least understood strategies for preventing violence. This workshop will cover: 1) relevant legislation and general principles to consider when navigating this tension, and 2) promising practices and challenging issues when communicating about violence risk.

## **How to...Manage Fear (15 August 2023)**

Managing the fear experience by potential victims of violence is an important and often overlooked task when conducting threat assessments. This workshop will cover: 1) the nature of fear and the implication for risk and safety, and 2) strategies for managing fear and supporting victims.

## **How to...Prevent Violence (17 October 2023)**

In most cases it is possible to identify warning signs for violence risk and to prevent violence from occurring. The workshop will cover: 1) identifying and reporting primary and secondary warning signs for violence, and 2) learning verbal and non-verbal skills to prevent escalation of violence.

## **How to...Assess and Manage Risk for Cyberviolence (12 December 2023)**

The assessment and management of violence perpetrated via electronic means is often plagued by controversy, confusion, and complexity surround the assessment and management of violence perpetrated via electronic means. This workshop will cover: 1) the definition, nature, and prevalence of cyber violence, and 2) special issues related to the assessment and management of cyber violence.
